## WHEN TO CALL 911 FOR EMERGENCIES

### CALL 911 if you:

- HAVE DIFFICULTY BREATHING
- HAVE A HIGH FEVER
- ARE CONFUSED, DISORIENTED, OR DIZZY
- HAVE SUDDEN, SEVERE PAIN
- HAVE SYMPTOMS OF HEART ATTACK OR STROKE
- HAVE AN ALLERGIC REACTION

### DO NOT CALL 911 if you:

- WANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19
- NEED A RIDE TO THE DOCTOR'S OFFICE
- WANT TO GET TESTED
- HAVE MILD SYMPTOMS
