Albemarle County's Residential Parking Ordinance

In 2020, the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors implemented a residential parking ordinance that restricts commercial and recreational vehicles from parking on residential streets.

WHAT THE ORDINANCE SAYS:

- Portable storage boxes may not be parked on the street, excluding the 48 hours before and after a new lease or move.
- There is no parking of commercial and recreational vehicle on residential streets.

TYPES OF COMMERCIAL AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES PROHIBITED FROM PARKING ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS:

 <p>Any vehicle with a gross weight of over 16,000 pounds, more than 25 feet long, eight feet high, or more than 102 inches wide.</p>	 <p>Any solid waste collection vehicle, tractor truck and/or trailer, dump truck, concrete mixer truck, tow truck, or any heavy construction equipment.</p>
 <p>Vehicles and trailers used for food or beverage storage or distribution.</p>	 <p>Trailers or semitrailers used for transporting landscaping, lawn-care, or construction equipment.</p>
 <p>Any vehicle used to transport passengers or property for compensation.</p>	 <p>School buses or vehicles previously used as school buses.</p>
 <p>Any watercraft.</p>	 <p>Any motor home or camping trailer.</p>
 <p>Any trailer or semitrailer, or vehicle carrying commercial freight in plain view.</p>	 <p>Vehicles with three or more axles.</p>

EXCEPTIONS

- Clearly marked and privately owned vehicles that are not-for-hire and driven by or for the transport of a person with a disability.
- A rented moving truck or for-hire moving company within 48 hours of a move.
- Vehicles that are picking up or unloading passengers, or when temporarily parked to perform work or service at that address.
- Any portable or mobile storage container or dumpster parked with a Virginia Department of Transportation permit.
