Sponsored by the Earlysville Area Residents' League, the Earlysville Parade began 27 years ago with an invitation to neighbors and families to gather and celebrate our nation's birthday. There were children with decorated bicycles and costumed pets, a wheelbarrow full of flowers from Green and Gold, Church groups, and assorted pedestrians and bicyclers-more than 200 strong.

In 2021, after a year which has challenged our resilience and kept us apart, this 25th year parade aims to recreate the original, with a focus on children and families, long-time neighbors and new friends.

All paraders will gather beside Earlysville Forest Drive beginning at 9:30 am. Please bring walking and bicycle-based groups. All ages are welcome. Represent your neighborhood with a sign. Musicians, singers, 4H members and their animals, scout troops, school groups, veterans and volunteer groups are welcome. All pets must be on a leash.

The parade will enter Earlysville Road at 10 am and walk to the Union Church, where we will exit onto the Church grounds. There will be a detour for vehicles through Earlysville Forest for the duration of the road closure. The road will reopen at the conclusion of the parade, about 11 am.

We hope to see you there, in a cool breeze and under a blue sky.


