## Election dates to keep in mind

First day of in-person early voting at your local registrar's office: Friday, September 22, 2023.

Deadline to <u>register to vote</u>, <u>or update an existing registration</u>: **October 16, 2023** (Voters may register after this date, through Election Day, and vote using a provisional ballot).

Deadline to apply for a ballot to be mailed to you: **October 27, 2023**. Your request must **be received by** your local voter registration office by 5:00 p.m.

Voter registration offices open for early voting: Saturday, October 28, 2023.

The last day of in-person early voting at your <u>local voter registration office</u>: **Saturday, November 4, 2023** at 5:00 p.m.

Election Day, Tuesday, November 7. Polls open 6 am to 7 pm.

Residential Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Days

Household Hazardous Waste Collection at the Ivy Materials Utilization Center will be held 9am-2pm on:

- Fall 2023
  - Friday, September 22, 2023
  - Saturday, September 23, 2023

HHW collections are free to residents of Albemarle County

### Commercial Hazardous Waste Collection

The next special commercial hazardous waste collection day at the Ivy Materials Utilization Center will be held on:

Sept 21, 2023

Qualifying businesses\* **must register** with MXI Environmental by September 7th to obtain an appointment. To Register, call or email Peggy Snead at (276) 628-6636, extension 203 or peggys@mxiinc.com." There is a fee associated with disposal.

\*This event is only open to qualifying Albemarle County and City of Charlottesville Businesses and commercial establishments. Qualifications are defined by federal law to include businesses that (1) generate no more than 100 kilograms (220 pounds) hazardous waste in a month, (2) generate no more than 1 kilogram (2.2 pounds) acutely hazardous waste in a month, and (3) store not more than 1,000 kilograms (2,200 pounds) hazardous waste.
