## Did you see the notice below included in your assessment notice?

Property owners who wish to request a review of their annual reassessment to the County Assessor must do so by **February 28, 2024**; this level of appeal is referred to as an Assessor's Review and is allowed by County Code §15-702. Appeals may also be made to the Board of Equalization if filed by **April 1, 2024**, or 30 days after the County Assessor has rendered his decision on a previously requested Assessor's Review, whichever is later.

The included notice is your opportunity to review your new assessment and the estimated tax levy and compare it to last year.


Now is also the time to:

- Ask for a review of your assessment.
- Appeal your assessment to the Board of Equalization.
- Apply for land use assessment.

If you have any questions, please call **434-296-5856** and ask for the appraiser who handles your property. Please note, waiting for your tax bill to arrive will be too late to address the items above.

If the notice says "Not enrolled in Land Use for 2024" but you thought your property was under the program, then please call **434-296-5856** and ask for the Land Use Administrator.
