Stickers are \$2 each and can be purchased at the Ivy Solid Waste & Recycling Center, the Green Mountain Country Store located at 5977 Scottsville Road, Scottsville, VA, or by mail with our Mail Order Form, available online.

### DID SOMEONE SAY MULCH?!?

We're excited to bring back our **FREE** mulch program! Did you know that mulching around your house offers several benefits? Besides looking good, mulch helps suppress weed growth, improves moisture retention, and assists with soil temperature regulation. To minimize organic waste from going to the landfill, we grind stumps, brush, and other usable organic debris that are brought into the Ivy Solid Waste & Recycling Center. Mulch is available on April 1 and will be available through the summer season. The general public is invited to load their own buckets, tubs, baskets, and bags. We are happy to help load trucks and trailers. Mulch can be picked up from the Ivy Solid Waste & Recycling Center located at **4576 Dick Woods Rd, Charlottesville, VA.**

Not sure what to do with that old broken recliner? Bring it to the **Ivy Solid Waste & Recycling Center** located at 4576 Dick Woods Rd, Charlottesville, VA and let us dispose of it for you! We collect a variety of refuse including domestic waste, construction debris, tires, vegetation, fill, and appliances. We welcome commercial and non-commercial vehicle traffic. Simply pull onto our scale just inside the main entrance and let our friendly staff direct you where to go.

### GENERAL FEES

Flat-rate locality fee.

**\$1/visit**  
**ALBEMARLE COUNTY RESIDENTS**

Residents who live outside the City of Charlottesville and in the County of Albemarle

**\$10/visit**  
**ALL OTHER VISITORS**

City of Charlottesville and neighboring counties.

### CATEGORY FEES

Fees are based on the type of refuse being delivered. Incurred costs are calculated to the nearest pound. Please note that the minimum charge per category is \$6.



**\$58/ton**  
**DOMESTIC WASTE**  
Household trash, broken furniture, non-recyclable plastics, old clothing, and bedding



**\$54/ton**  
**VEGETATION & YARD WASTE**  
Stumps, tree branches, grass clippings, and leaves



**\$58/ton**  
**CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS**  
Lumber, shingles, plywood, cinder blocks, piping, rebar, and flooring



**\$10/ton**  
**CLEAN FILL**  
Non-contaminated dirt, clean concrete, and asphalt



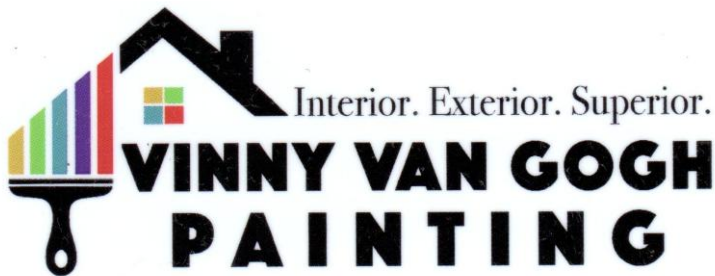

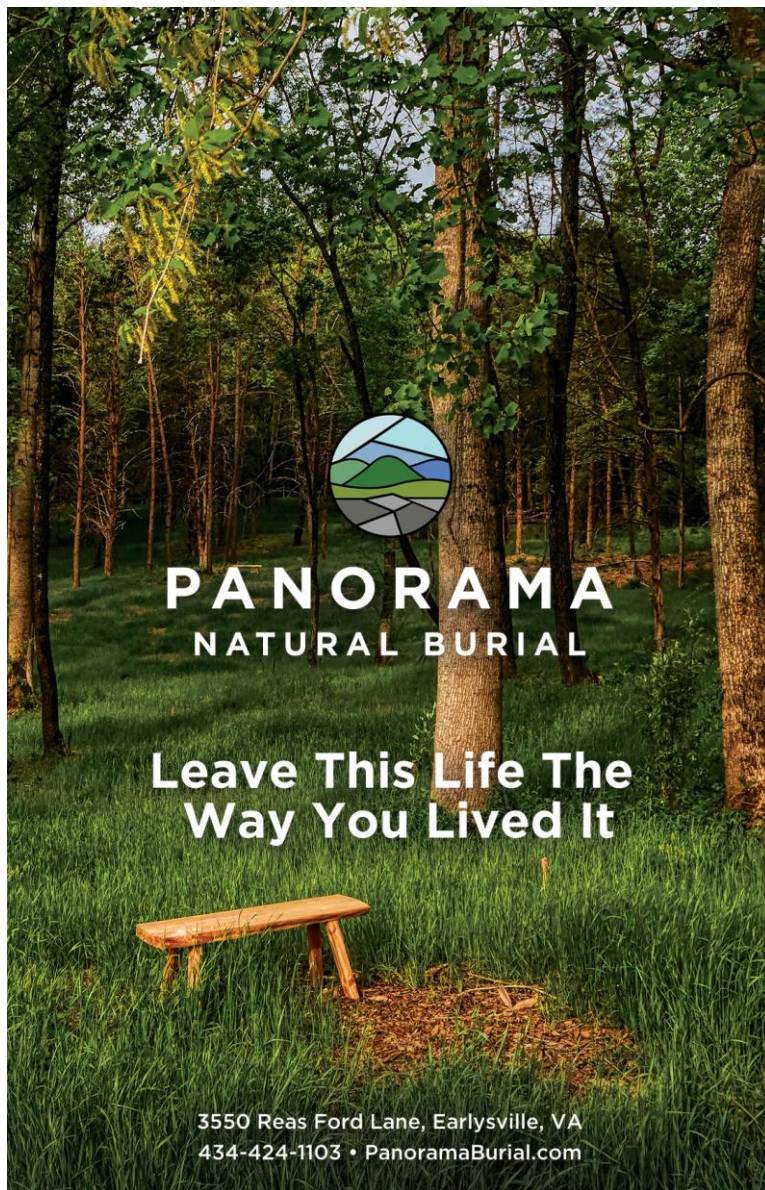
