- After May 27, voters can use Same Day Registration to cast a provisional ballot between May 28 and June 17, if eligible to register to vote. For more details on eligibility for Same Day Registration, please contact the Elections Office.
- Early in-person voting began on May 2, 2025. Early in-person voting at the Voter Registration Office at the 5th Street County Office Building is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 5 pm. The final two Saturdays, June 7 and June 14, will also be open for early in-person voting from 8:30 am to 5 pm.
- Voters may apply for a mail-in ballot now. Applications must be received by the Voter Registration

HELP STOP THE SPREAD OF IMPORTED FIRE ANTS

This invasive species has been found in Albemarle County.





- Fire ants bite and sting repeatedly. Their venom can cause severe allergic reactions in some individuals.
- Fire ants attack when disturbed. Their mounds may appear as flat areas of dirt or raised dirt piles with no visible opening.
- If you find fire ants in Virginia, DO NOT DISTURB THE MOUNDS. Disturbing them can trigger attacks or cause the colony to relocate.




